**ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION ACT, 1989 (ACT NO. 73 OF 1989)** 

GENERAL NOTICE: EXTENSION OF THE APPEAL PERIOD REGARDING THE AUTHORISATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 22(3) OF THE ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION ACT NO. 73 OF 1989 TO CONSTRUCT THE N2 WILD COAST TOLL ROAD

The Director-General of Environmental Affairs and Tourism has approved on 3 December 2003 the application by the South African National Roads Agency Limited to construct the N2 Wild Coast Toll Road. In terms of the relevant act, interested and affected parties can submit appeals against this decision within a period of 30 days.

I, Mohammed Valli Moosa, Minister of Environmental Affairs and Tourism, in terms of section 28(A)(3)(b) of the Environment Conservation Act, 1989 (Act No. 73 of 1989), hereby exempts all interested and affected parties from regulation 11(1) of Government Notice No. R. 1182 of 5 September 1997 and provides a further 30 days, which effectively extends the appeal period to 31 January 2004 for this project.

This notice also applies to the period 2 to 5 January 2004.
