- 1.6 Specified period: February 2007 to February 2010.
- 1.7 Ethanol Africa Bothaville Project was awarded 7 points and afforded a preferred status. The approved amount of additional industrial investment allowance in respect of industrial assets to be used for Ethanol Africa Bothaville Project is R53 336 118, that is the remainder of the R10 billion allocated budget.
- 1.8 Potential national revenue to be forgone by virtue of deduction of the approved allowance for Ethanol Africa Bothaville Project will be R15 467 474.
- 1.9 Ethanol Africa Bothaville Project is expected to create 2365 direct and indirect jobs before the end of its specified period.
