## NOTICE TO DEFER THE GENERAL EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT, 2008 (No.68 of 2008)

In terms of item 2(3) (b) (a) of the Consumer Protection Act, 2008 (No. 68 of 2008) ("the Act"), the Minister of Trade and Industry may, by notice published in the *Gazette* at least 20 business days before the 24<sup>th</sup> of October 2010 defer the general effective date of the Act for a period of not more than six additional months, on the ground that additional time is required for adequate preparation of the administrative systems necessary to ensure the efficient and effective implementation of that provision.

I, Rob Davies, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby defer the general effective date of the Act until 31 March 2011.
