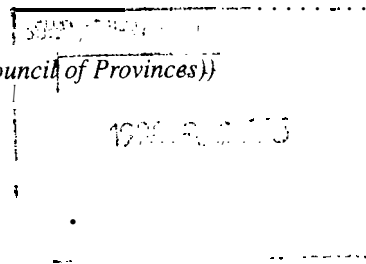

CLAUSE 1

1. On page 6, in line 7, before “Department” to insert “national”.

CLAUSE 6

1. On page 10, after line 31, to insert the following subsection:

(2) The Minister must, prior to appointing the members contemplated in subsection (1)(a), publish the names of the persons proposed to be appointed as such members in the *Gazette* and invite *comment* on the suitability of such members for appointment.

CLAUSE 7

1. On page 12, from line 7, to omit “from the registrar on the activities and operations of the agent y”.
2. On page 12, from line 17, to omit subsection (2).

CLAUSE 18

1. On page 18, in line 31, after “section 17(1)(j)” to insert “or section 19(2)(b)”.

CLAUSE 21

1. On page 24, in line 8, to omit “or”.

CLAUSE 22

1. On page 24, from line 48, to omit “under circumstances indicating that such failure is due to the fault of such infringer as determined by the court”

CLAUSE 32

1. On page **30**, after line 16, to insert the following subsection:

(2) Subject to section 6 of the Finance and Financial Adjustments Acts Consolidation Act, 1977 (Act No. 11 of 1977), any fine received in respect of any conviction under the national and provincial laws relating to road traffic, must be paid over monthly to the issuing authority under whose authority the infringement notice was issued, and if it was not issued under the authority of such authority, to the

issuing authority within whose area of jurisdiction the infringement was committed.

CLAUSE 34

1. In the Afrikaans text, on page 31, in line 27, to omit “onbestaanbaar” and to substitute “teenstrydig”.
