NATURE OF OFFENCE:

SANCTION

- 1. The Respondent in terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(i) of the Act, is cautioned and reprimanded not to conduct himself in the manner he did in future.
- 2. The Respondent is liable for the amount of R10 000 (Ten Thousand Rand) in terms of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the Act to which half of it will be suspended for a period of 12 months on condition that the Respondent is not found guilty of any transgression of the Code of Conduct committed during the period of suspension.
