**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT****NO. 256****23 MARCH 2017****NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 91 OF THE NATIONAL LAND TRANSPORT  
ACT, 2009 (ACT NO.5 OF 2009)**

1. I, Weziwe Tikana, by virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of section 91 of the National Land Transport Act, No.5 of 2009 (“the Act”) as the Member of the Executive Council for the Province of the Eastern Cape responsible for Transport, Safety and Liaison, being of the opinion that extraordinary measures are necessary to normalize transport services in the areas referred to in this notice, which areas is affected by violence, unrest, conflict or instability, hereby declare “Extraordinary measures” for six (6) weeks in the following areas:
  - (a) Port St Johns
  - (b) Ngqeleni
  - (c) Mthatha
  - (d) Libode
  - (e) Lusikisiki
2. Having declared Extraordinary measures in the above area, I intend invoking the provisions of Section 91(2) (a) and/or (b) of the Act, further details whereof shall be published by me through an appropriate medium in terms of section 91 of the Act.
3. Any interested or affected persons may make representations to me as to why my decision made in terms of this notice should be reconsidered. The representations must:
  - (a) be made in writing, by interested or affected person(s) or duly authorized representative(s) thereof
  - (b) clearly state the bases on which such person(s) claims(s) to be interested or affected
  - (c) clearly states the grounds on which my decision is sought to be reconsidered

- (d) be delivered by hand within seven days from the date of publication of this notice in the gazette to:
