APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE BY BEAT FM

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received an application from Beat FM, for the amendment of its Radio Frequency Spectrum (RFS) Licence lodged in terms of the provision of section 31 (4) of the Electronic Communications Act, No. 36 of 2005 (ECA) read with Regulation 9 of the Radio Spectrum Frequency Regulations of 2015 as published in Government Gazette No. 38641 (as amended). Beat FM seeks to add seven (7) transmitters within its licensed area of the Free State Province. The proposed additional transmitters will be located at Harrismith, Bloemfontein, Bethlehem, Kimberly, Kroonstad, Petrus Steyn and Senekal. The details and specifications of the application are contained in the table below.

If the public hearing is held, only the persons who lodged the representation will be allowed to present.

Beat FM must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand **OR** has sent a copy of such response by registered mail **OR** by fax **OR** by email to the relevant person(s) having made such written representations.
