I wish to inform the Secretary of the Cabinet of all the functions I delegated to Ms Noxolo Kiviet in her role as Deputy Minister for Public Works and Infrastructure (DPWI)

These functions include the DPWI's Prestige portfolio, responsible for providing fully furnished residential and office accommodation to all political office bearers, the Chief Justice and Deputy Chief Justice, Speaker of the National Assembly and Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly, Members of Parliament, Directors-General and sessional officials.

The Deputy Minister (DM) is also responsible for executive oversight of following entities:

- the Independent Development Trust (IDT),
- Agrément South Africa (ASA),
- Council for the Built Environment (CBE),
- and the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB).

The DM is also responsible for:

- the South African Council for Architectural Profession (SACAP),
- the South African Council for Project and Construction Management Professions (SACPCMP),
- the South African Council for Landscape Architectural Profession (SACLAP),

- the South African Council for the Property Valuers Profession (SACPVP),
- the South African Council for the Quantity Surveying Profession (SACQSP),
- and the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA).

I am currently re-organising the Department to better deliver on its extended mandate that includes Infrastructure. More functions may be added in the future to the Deputy Minister's responsibilities.
