

ENTITIES THAT REPORT TO THE EMPLOYMENT AND LABOUR MINISTER

Name of public entity	Mandate
Unemployment Insurance Fund (UIF)	The Unemployment Insurance Fund contributes to the alleviation of poverty in South Africa by providing short-term unemployment insurance to all workers who qualify for unemployment related benefits. The Fund is financed by a dedicated tax on the wage bill
Compensation Fund (CF)	The Compensation Fund's main objective is to provide compensation for disability, illness and death resulting from occupational injuries and diseases
Productivity South Africa (Productivity SA)	Productivity SA is mandated by government, organised labour and organised business to improve the productive capacity of the economy and thus contribute to South Africa's socio-economic development and competitiveness
Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration	The Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA) is mandated to promote social justice and fairness in the workplace by delivering ethical, qualitative, innovative and cost effective dispute management and resolution services, institution building services, education, training and development, and efficient administration.
National Economic Development and Labour Council (NEDLAC)	The National Economic Development and Labour Council was established in terms of the National Economic Development and Labour Council Act, 1994 which requires organised labour, organised business, community based organisations and government, as a collective, to promote the goals of economic growth; participate in economic decision making and social equity; seek to reach consensus and conclude agreements on matters pertaining to social and economic policy; consider all proposed labour legislation relating to labour market policy and all significant changes to social and economic policy before these are introduced in Parliament; and encourage and promote the formulation of coordinated policy on social and economic matters
Supported Employment Enterprises (SEE)	The SEE is established in terms of the Employment Services Act to provide employment for people with special disabilities in the various factories across provinces that manufacture wood, linen and steel products.
