LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL STRUCTURES ACT, 1998 (ACT NO.117 OF 1998)

ELECTION OF MUNICIPAL OFFICE BEARERS AND REPRESENTATIVES TO DISTRICT COUNCILS

The Minister for Provincial and Local Government has, under section 92 of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998), made the regulations set out in the schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998), has that meaning and –
“the Act” means the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998),

Election of municipal office bearers

2. If at a further meeting held in terms of item 8(1) of Schedule 3 to the Act –
 - (a) only two candidates are nominated; or
 - (b) two candidates remain after the elimination procedure in item 7 of schedule 3 has been applied,and those two candidates received the same number of votes the MEC for local government in a province may direct that the result must be determined by lot.

Election of representatives of local councils to district councils

3. If at the election of the representatives of a local council to its district council in terms of –
- (a) item 16 of Schedule 2 to the Act, two or more candidates each receive the most votes; or
 - (b) item 20(2) of Schedule 2, two or more lists each receive the highest surplus for one remaining seat,
- the MEC for local government in a province may direct that the result must be determined by lot.
