TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. INTRODUCTION

Government prescribes the price of petrol and the retail margin is a controlled element in the price of petrol. The retail margin is calculated on the basis of an investigation into the driveway-related activities of service stations.

2. SCOPE OF WORK AND METHODOLOGY

The contractor is expected to perform a cost survey of the proposed sample of 100 service stations in line with the guidelines at a sample of service stations in terms of locality, turnover and category.

The sample, number of service stations per category, the category that represents the most service stations, geographical location and turnover of the service stations, will be determined in conjunction with the Department of Minerals and Energy, the Fuel Retailers Association and the Retail Motor Industry Organisation. The following categories would applicable.
