

NOTICE 771 OF 2002
DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY
MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1941
(ACT No. 17 OF 1941)

PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF A CERTAIN NAME, ABBREVIATION AND EMBLEM

I, Alexander Erwin, Minister of Trade and Industry, hereby prohibit under section 15 (1) of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941 (Act No. 17 of 1941), the use of the undermentioned name, abbreviation and emblem in connection with a trade, business, profession or occupation or in connection with a trade mark, mark or trade description applied to goods, other than the use thereof by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) or its mandatories. Proprietors of identical or similar marks already in use will not be affected by this prohibition.
