#### REGULATIONS FOR THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE

The Minister for Safety and Security has, under section 24(1), of the South African Police Service Act, 1995 (Act No. 68 of 1995), made the regulations in the Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

##### DEFINITION

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" mean that the Regulations promulgated by Government Notice R.203 of 14 February 1964, as amended.

##### AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 18 OF THE REGULATIONS

2. Regulation 18 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for item III to Schedule C of the following item:

##### "III BADGES OF RANK

National Commissioner	Crossed sword and baton below four hexagons.
Deputy National Commissioner	Crossed sword and baton below a star and three hexagons.
Provincial Commissioner, Divisional Commissioner	Crossed sword and baton below three hexagons.
Assistant Commissioner	Crossed sword and baton below two hexagons.
Director	Three stars in a triangle below a hexagon.

Senior Superintendent	Two stars below a hexagon.
Superintendent	One star below a hexagon.
Captain	Three stars.
Inspector	A sleevebadge with two stars and the words 'POLICE' and 'Inspector'.
Sergeant	A sleevebadge with a three-bar chevron below a hexagon and with the words 'POLICE' and 'Sergeant'.
Constable	A sleevebadge with the badge described in paragraph I(a) and the words "POLICE" and 'Constable'."

3. These regulations shall come into operation on the date of publication thereof.
