NOTICE 1016 OF 2002

AMENDMENT TO TERMS OF REFERENCE AS PUBLISHED IN GOVERNMENT GAZETTE No. 22711 DATED 5 OCTOBER 2001

WHEREAS in the above *Gazette*, No. 22711 dated 5 October 2001, the South African Human Rights Commission published Terms of Reference for the conducting of an investigation and an inquiry into the incidence of human rights violations within farming communities and for the holding of public inquiry.

AND WHEREAS the said notice provided inter alia that:

"the panel will consist of at least three members of the Commission. In addition, the Chairperson may invite one or two persons with expertise on any matters referred to in the terms of reference of this investigation and inquiry.

The final report of the Inquiry and the findings and recommendations will be made public at a National Conference to be convened by the South African Human Rights Commission."

And whereas it is intended to amend the above quoted Terms of Reference to read as follows:

- "1. The panel will consist of not less than three persons, two of whom shall be members of the Commission and at least one of whom shall be a person with expertise on matters relating to the farming communities in South Africa.
- 1.2 The final report of the inquiry, the findings and the recommendations will be made public at a launch meeting to be convened by the South African Human Rights Commission."
