DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

MANUFACTURING DEVELOPMENT ACT No. 187 of 1983

I, Alexander Erwin, Minister of Trade and Industry, by virtue of the power vested in me in terms of Chapter II, Regulation 3 Gazette No. 6936 Vol. 426 dated 1 December 2000 Act (Act No. 187 of 1993 as amended), promulgated a notice in respect of the Industrial Development Zone Programme.

DESIGNATION OF AN AREA AS AN INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ZONE (IDZ)

1. DESIGNATION OF AN AREA AS AN IDZ: JOHANNESBURG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

In terms of Chapter II, Regulation 3 (a) of the Regulations, it is hereby proclaimed that an area, which is called the Johannesburg International Airport Industrial Development Zone, is designated as an IDZ.

The aforesaid designation is made in accordance and after due compliance with the prescribed requirements as provided for in Chapter II, Regulation 3 (a) (1) to (6) and (b) (1) to (3) of the Regulations.

2. THE LOCATION OF THE JOHANNESBURG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ZONE

The proposed Johannesburg International Airport Industrial Development Zone is located adjacent to the Johannesburg International Airport. Approximately 725 hectares of land is potentially available for the development of an IDZ. Within this area is the initial phase 1 and 2 of the proposed IDZ comprising 282 hectares. The area has been the subject of an extensive Preliminary Site Development Plan by the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Council.

The Johannesburg International Airport IDZ falls within the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Council. The plan showing boundaries of the proposed IDZ is attached as Annexure A and Annexure B shows the actual position or location of each property within the proposed IDZ.

3. APPLICATIONS FOR PROVISIONAL OPERATOR PERMITS

Any party interested in obtaining a provisional IDZ Operator Permit (PIDZOP) is invited to submit a Provisional Johannesburg International Airport Operator Permit application to the Manufacturing Development Board. Application must comply with Chapter IV, Regulation 10 (d) and (e) of the Regulations. 
