CORRECTION NOTICE

In terms of Item 4 of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), I Phumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka, Minister of Minerals and Energy, hereby publish the amendments to the Minerals Act Regulations in the Schedule.

The schedule hereunder is a correction to and replaces Government Notice No. R918 appearing in Government Gazette No 23585 of 2 July 2002.

SCHEDULE

1. Regulation 1 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by the insertion after subregulation 1 (5) of the following definition:

"(5A) **Council** means the Mine Health and Safety Council established in terms of section 41 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act No 29 of 1996)"

2. Regulation 35.1 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by its substitution with the following:

"35.1 There is hereby established a safety research account to which shall be credited -

- a. levies paid in terms of regulation 35.2(a)(iv);
- b. fines imposed in terms of regulation 35.3; [and]
- c. any income accrued from the investment of money in that account,

which shall be used for research and surveys regarding, and for the promotion of [industrial] occupational health and safety at mines and works and for the administration costs of the overall programme for relevant occupational health and safety research."

3. Regulation 35.2 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by the insertion after sub-regulation 35.2(d) of the following sub-regulation:

"(e) conclude an agreement with the Council for the provision of administrative, secretarial and other support services required for the administration of the overall programme for relevant health and safety research:"
