SCHEDULE

- Regulation 1 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act. 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by the insertion after subregulation 1 (5) of the following definition:
 - "(5A) Council means the Mine Health and Safety Council established in terms of section 41 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act No 29 of 1996)"
- 2. Regulation 35.1 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by its substitution with the following:
 - "35.1 There is hereby established a safety research account to which shall be credited
 - a. levies paid in terms of regulation 35.2(a)(iv);
 - b. fines imposed in terms of regulation 35.3; [and]
 - c. any income accrued from the investment of money in that account,

which shall be used for research and surveys regarding, and for the promotion of [industrial] <u>occupational health and</u> safety at mines and works <u>and for the administration costs of the overall programme for</u> relevant occupational health and safety research."

- 3. Regulation 35.2 of the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act 50 of 1991), in force in terms of Schedule 4 of the Mine Health and Safety Act, 1996 (Act 29 of 1996), is hereby amended by the insertion after sub-regulation 35.2(d) of the following sub-regulation:
 - "(e) conclude an agreement with the Council for the provision of administrative, secretarial and other support services required for the administration of the overall programme for relevant health and safety research:"
