NATIONAL ROUTE 1: GREAT NORTH TOLL ROAD: WARMBATHS INTERCHANGE- BEIT BRIDGE: KRANSKOP-, NYL-, SEBETIELA-; AND CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZAS: PUBLICATION OF THE AMOUNTS OF TOLL FOR THE VARIOUS CATEGORIES OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND THE DATE UPON AND TIMES AT WHICH THE TOLL TARIFFS SHALL BECOME PAYABLE

The Head of the Department hereby, in terms of section 27 (3) (c) of The South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act, 1998 (Act No: 7 of 1998) [the Act], makes known that the amounts of toll which may be levied in terms of section 27 (1) (b) of the Act at the Kranskop-, Nyl-, Sebetiela-; and Capricorn Toll Plazas (located on the Great North Toll Road, declared in terms of Government Notice No's: 326 of 1996 and 19310 of 1998) and the date and time at which the amounts of toll shall become payable, have been determined by the Minister of Transport in terms of section 27 (3) (a) of the Act and that the said amounts shall be levied in terms of section 27 (3) (b) and (d) thereof, as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. DEFINITIONS:

- 1.1 "Motor vehicle" means an entity comprising of one or more mechanically powered units with or without any trailer(s) physically joined by means of tow bars, tow ropes or mechanical articulation, and includes-
 - (a) a motor cycle;
 - (b) a motor tricycle;
 - (c) a motor car;
 - (d) a vehicle which has pedals and a mechanically powered units as an integral part thereof or attached thereto and which is designed or adapted to be propelled by means of either such pedals or such mechanical unit or both; and
 - (e) a light delivery vehicle (a bakkie)
- 1.2 "Motor cycle" means a motor vehicle, which has two wheels and includes any such vehicle having a sidecar attached thereto.
- 1.3 "Motor tricycle" means a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle with a sidecar, which has three wheels and which is designed to be driven by means of the type of controls usually fitted to a motorcycle.
- 1.4 "Motor car" means a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle or a motor tricycle, designed or adapted solely or principally for the conveyance of persons not exceeding sixteen (16) in number.
- 1.5 "Light delivery vehicle" means a motor vehicle designed or adapted for the conveyance of persons and freight with a tare not exceeding one comma five (1,5) ton and with no heavy axle as defined in paragraph 1.7 hereunder.
- 1.6 "Axle" means a device or set of devices, whether continuous across the width of the vehicle or not, about which the wheels of the vehicle rotate and which is so placed that, when the vehicle is travelling straight ahead, the vertical center-lines of such wheels are in one vertical plane at right angles to the longitudinal center-line of such vehicle.
- 1.7 "Heavy axle" means an axle the wheels of which are fitted with tyres of a size (bead seat diameter) greater than 406,4 millimetres (16 inches), or an axle with more than two (2) wheels irrespective of tyre size but excluding any axle of a motor cycle, a motor tricycle or a motor car.
- 1.8 "Light vehicle" means a motor vehicle, other than heavy vehicles as defined hereunder.
- 1.9 "Heavy vehicle" means a motor vehicle with at least one heavy axle and/ or a motor vehicle exceeding a tare of one comma five (1,5) ton.

- 1.10 "Abnormal vehicle" means a motor vehicle exceeding the legal dimensions as described in the Road Traffic Act, 1989, or in any other law.
- 1.11 "Trailer" means a vehicle which is not self-propelled and which is designed or adapted to be drawn by a motor vehicle but does not include a sidecar attached to a motorcycle.

2. CLASSIFICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES:

Class I: Light vehicles:

Light vehicles are motor vehicles, other than heavy vehicles as defined hereunder, with or without a trailer, and include motor cycles, motor cars and light delivery vehicles.

Class II: Medium heavy vehicles

Medium heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with two axles.

Class III: Large heavy vehicles

Large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with three or four axles.

Class IV: Extra large heavy vehicles

Extra large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with five or more axles.

3. AMOUNTS OF TOLL:

3.1 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the **Warmbaths- and Naboomspruit South Interchanges** (or any part thereof) are payable at the **Kranskop Mainline Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R19.00 CLASS II: R47.00 CLASS III: R56.00 CLASS IV: R75.00

3.2 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the **Warmbaths- and Nylstroom Interchanges** (or any part thereof) are payable at the **Kranskop Ramp Toll Plazas** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R 5.00 CLASS II: R14.00 CLASS III: R16.00 CLASS IV: R24.00

3.3 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the Naboomspruit North- and Pietersburg Interchanges (or any part thereof) are payable at the Nyl Mainline Toll Plaza and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R24.00 CLASS II: R45.00 CLASS III: R54.00 CLASS IV: R73.00 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the Naboomspruit North- and Potgietersrus South Interchanges (or any part thereof) are payable at the Nyl Ramp Toll Plazas and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R 7.50 CLASS II: R14.00 CLASS III: R16.00 CLASS IV: R21.00

3.5 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the **Potgietersrus North- and Pietersburg Interchanges** are payable at the **Sebetiela Ramp Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS II: R 7.50 CLASS III: R14.00 CLASS IV: R17.00 CLASS IV: R23.00

3.6 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the extended Great North Toll Road between the **Pietersburg Interchange** and **Louis Trichardt** is payable at the **Capricorn Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows;

CLASS I: R19.00 CLASS II: R48.00 CLASS III: R58.00 CLASS IV: R77.00

- 4 HEAVY VEHICLE DISCOUNT AVAILABLE AT THE KRANSKOP-, NYL-, SEBETIELA-; AND CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZAS:
- 4.1 A discount of **five percent (5%)** on the toll tariffs, for **Class II, III; and IV** (**heavy vehicles**) only and as described in Paragraph No's: 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.5; and 3.6, above is granted, irrespective of the number of trips, when a valid **Credit Card (Visa- Master Card)**, or a valid **Fleet Management Card**; is tendered for payment at the Kranskop-, Nyl-, Sebetiela-; and Capficorn Toll Plazas for usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the Warmbaths Interchange and Louis Trichardt (or a part thereof). This discount will, however, not be granted to commuters that qualify for the Local Commuter Discounts, available at the Capricorn Toll Plaza and as described in Paragraph No: 6 below.


- 5 FREQUENT USER DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZA:
- 5.1 Frequent User Discounts on the toll tariff, for Class I motor vehicles only and as described in Paragraph No: 3.6 above, are granted on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Capricorn Toll Plaza. The following discounts are offered when a valid "Frequent User Card", approved by The South African National Roads Agency Limited, is tendered for payment at the Capricorn Toll Plaza for the usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road between the Pietersburg Interchange and Louis Trichardt:
 - (a) for 20 to 39 trips per single card during a calendar month 20% discount; and
 - (b) for **40** and more trips per single card during a calendar month **40%** discount.
- 6. LOCAL COMMUTER DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZA:
- 6.1 Local Commuter Discounts on the toll tariffs, **for all vehicle classes**, described in Paragraph No: 3.6 above are granted to registered bona fide residents of- or employees in the area indicated on the attached Local Commuter Tariff Area Map (Annexure A), on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Capricorn Toll Plaza and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R 6.00 CLASS II: R12.00 CLASS III: R14.00 CLASS IV: R20.00

- 7 LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPERATORS DISCOUNT AVAILABLE AT THE CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZA:
- 7.1 A Local Public Transport Operators Discount on the toll tariffs, for Class I motor vehicles only and as described in Paragraph No: 3.6 above, is granted to registered bona fide Local Public Transport Operators; operating in the area indicated on the attached Local Commuter Tariff Area Map (Annexure A), on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Capricorn Toll Plaza and shall be R6.00 per trip.

- 8 FREQUENT USER DISCOUNTS FOR REGISTERED BONE FIDE LOCAL COMMUTERS AND REGISTERED BONE FIDE LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPERATORS:
- 8.1 Frequent User Discounts on the toll tariffs, for Class I motor vehicles only and as described in Paragraph No's: 7 and 8 above are granted on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Capricorn Toll Plaza. The following discounts are offered when a valid Credit Card (Visa or Master Card), or a valid Fleet Management Card is registered as a Frequent User Card; on approval by the South African National Road Agency Limited, is tendered for payment at the Capricorn Toll Plaza for usage of that section of the Great North Toll Road, known as the Local Commuter Tariff Area (or part thereof):
 - (a) for 20 to 39 trips per single card during a calendar month- 20% discount; and
 - (b) for **40 and more trips** per single card during a calendar month-**40%discount**.
- 9 INFORMATION REGARDING DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE CAPRICORN TOLL PLAZA
- 9.1 Information, documentation and application forms regarding available discounts and related costs are available at the Capricorn Toll Plaza
- 10. The Great North Toll Road shall be open to traffic for 24 hours a day.
- 11. The date upon and the time at which the said amounts of toll shall become payable at the Kranskop-, Nyl-, Sebetiela-; and Capricorn, shall be **March 1, 2003** at **00H00**.
