#### **NOTICE 967 OF 2003**

#### **ELECTORAL COMMISSION**

#### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

The Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that it has in terms of section 11 of the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000, compiled the election timetable set out below to apply to the municipal by-election to be held on 7 May 2003 in respect of Ward 18 of the Breede Valley Municipality Municipality as called in terms of Provincial Notice P.N. 91/2003 and published in the Provincial Gazette Extraordinary No. 5994 of the Province of the Western Cape on 28 March 2003. A reference to "section" in this election timetable is a reference to that section in the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000.

#### Cut-off time for act to be performed

An act required in terms of this Act to be performed by not later than a date in the election timetable must be performed before 17:00 on that date, unless otherwise specified.

#### Certification of the voters'roll

By 31 March 2003 the chief electoral officer must certify the segments of the voters' roll for the voting districts to be used in the by-elections in terms of section 6(2) (a).

#### Notice that lists of addresses of voting stations are available for inspection

By not later than 3 April 2003 the chief electoral officer must give notice that copies of a list of voting stations and their addresses will be available for inspection at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 19(5).

## Notice of route of mobile voting stations

If the Commission decides to use mobile voting stations in the byelections, the Commission must by not later than 3 April 2003 give notice of the route, including the locations and estimated times of stopping of each mobile voting station in terms of section 22(1).

### Cut -off date for nomination of ward candidates to contest an election

By not later than 17h00 on 11 April 2003, the nomination of a person to contest the by-election in a municipality as a ward candidate, must be submitted to the Commission's local representative on a prescribed form and in the prescribed manner in terms of section 17 (1).

## Cut - off date for compilation and certification of ward candidate lists

By 11 April 2003 the Commission must compile for each ward a list of ward candidates, certify those lists for that by-election, and keep copies of the lists available at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 18 (1).

### Cut-off date for issuing certificates

By 14 April 2003 the Commission must issue to each ward candidate contesting the by-election, a prescribed certificate in terms of section 18(1)(d).
