# INTERNATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT NO. 28 OF 1974) DESIGNATION OF AIRPORTS AS SANITARY AIRPORTS

I, Mantombazana Edmie Tshabalala-Msimang, Minister of Health, hereby designate, in terms of section 3 of the International Health Regulations Act, 1974 (Act No. 28 of 1974), the airports in the Republic listed in the Schedule as sanitary airports.

#### SCHEDULE

#### 1. Definitions

In this Schedule any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning and, unless the context otherwise indicates -

"sanitary airport" means any airport designated in terms of section 3(1)(b) of the Act and deemed by that section to be a sanitary airport for the purposes of the International Health Regulations;

"the Act" means the International Health Regulations Act, 1974 (Act No. 28 of 1974).

### 2. Airports

The following airports are hereby designated as sanitary airports:

- (1) Bloemfontein
- (2) Durban International
- (3) Cape Town International
- (4) Gateway
- (5) Johannesburg International
- (6) Lanseria
- (7) Nelspruit
- (8) Pilanesberg

- (9) Port Elizabeth
- (10) Upington

### 3. Repeal

Government Notice No. R. 856 of 26 April 1991 is hereby repealed in so far as it relates to sanitary airports.
