INTERNATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT NO. 28 OF 1974)**DESIGNATION OF PORTS AS APPROVED PORTS**

I, Mantombazana Edmie Tshabalala-Msimang, Minister of Health, hereby designate, in terms of section 3 of the International Health Regulations Act, 1974 (Act No. 28 of 1974), the ports in the Republic listed in the Schedule as approved ports.

SCHEDULE**1. Definitions**

In this Schedule any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning and, unless the context otherwise indicates –

“approved port” means any port designated in terms of section 3(1)(a) of the Act and deemed by that section to be an approved port for the purposes of Article 17 of the International Health Regulations;

“the Act” means the International Health Regulations Act, 1974 (Act No. 28 of 1974).

2. Ports


