GENERAL NOTICE FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PEOPLE'S HOUSING PARTNERSHIP TRUST

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing invites nominations of persons as candidates for membership of the Board of Trustees for the People's Housing Partnership Trust (PHPT).
- 2. Persons who are experienced, knowledgeable and skilled in the following fields, should be nominated; and such competencies must be clearly reflected in their curriculum vitae:
 - Theoretical and/or practical knowledge in housing development;
 - Extensive knowledge in alternative housing development;
 - □ Engineering and/or Town and Regional Planning skills;
 - Knowledge in housing policy implementation;
 - D Mobilisation and organisational skills; and
 - Social facilitation skills.

Candidates for membership of the board must be of unquestionable integrity, i.e. never found guilty and convicted for fraud, corruption and malpractices.

- 3. The following matters have a bearing on the appointment of the members of the board:
 - The board shall consist of not more than six and proper persons who have knowledge, qualifications or experience in the field of housing development.
 - Members of the board shall be appointed in accordance with a procurement policy that is consistent with section 217 of the Constitution, and must be appointed only after the Minister has, through the media, and by notice in the *Gazette* invited nominations of persons as candidates for the respective positions on the board.
 - A member of the board is appointed for the period determined by the Minister at his or her appointment, and may be reappointed on the termination of that period.
 - The Minister may at any time terminate the membership of a member of the board for reasons which are just and fair.
 - A member of the board other than a person who is in the full-time employment of the State, is paid an allowance determined by the Minister.
 - A member of the board ceases to be a member if—
 - (a) he or she resigns;
 - (b) his or her estate is sequestrated or he or she applies for assistance contemplated in section 10
 (1) (c) of the Agricultural Credit Act, 1966;
 - (c) he or she becomes of unsound mind;
 - (d) he or she is convicted of an offence and sentenced to imprisonment without the option of a fine; and
 - (e) he or she becomes a member of Parliament, a provincial legislature, a municipal council, the cabinet or the Executive Council of a Province.
- 4. A nomination must be accompanied by a comprehensive curriculum vitae of the nominee.
- 5. Nominations must be submitted to the Department of Housing within 30 days after the publication of this invitation-
