<b>KaMbambiso</b>	A post office SE of kaapmuiden in Mpumalanga
<b>Katjibane</b>	A village NNW of Siyabuswa in Mpumalanga
<b>Kono</b>	A town S of Kuruman in Northern Cape
<b>Magogeni</b>	A settlement in Mpumalanga (formerly Jeppe's Reef)
<b>Makhado</b>	A township in Limpopo (formerly Louis Trichardt)
<b>Marapyane</b>	A settlement in Mpumalanga (formerly Skilpadfontein)
<b>Mbhongo</b>	A village SW of Siyabuswa in Mpumalanga (formerly Almansdrift B)
<b>Metsimatala</b>	A town E of Postmasburg in Northern Cape
<b>Mhlambanyatsi River</b>	A river in Mpumalanga (formerly Slabhojet)
<b>Mhlambanyatsi</b>	A settlement in Mpumalanga (formerly Buffelspruit)
<b>Midstream Estate</b>	A town in Gauteng (formerly Midstream Estates)
<b>Mphephu</b>	A township in Limpopo (formerly Dzanani Township)
<b>Mtilane</b>	A river SE of Kaapmuiden in Mpumalanga (correction of spelling from Ntulane)
<b>Sefogane River</b>	A river N of Graskop in Mpumalanga (formerly Treur River)
<b>Seabe</b>	A settlement NWW of Siyabuswa in Mpumalanga (formerly De Putten)
<b>Umhlanga Gateway</b>	A town SW from Umhlanga Rocks CBD in KwaZulu Natal
