Name of product: Duoflex acrylic modified cementitious wall coating
Certificate holder: Union Flooring Tiles (Pty) Ltd
Description: Duoflex is an acrylic modified cementitious coloured wall coating that is more flexible than a pure cement coating and with waterproofing properties, for one coat application to sound properly prepared external and internal walls surfaces as follows:

- concrete bricks and blocks
 - sand cement plaster
 - sand cement bagged finishes
- In all regions of South Africa.

Douflex coatings consist of three components – powder, emulsion and water that are mixed in prescribed proportions and are liberally applied to the wall surfaces using a block brush.

The Duoflex powder consists of white or grey Portland cement, selected fine aggregate, admixtures and colouring additives. The powder is supplied in a variety of colours in 25 kg plastic bags. The Duoflex emulsion is supplied in 2,5 litre containers. These quantities are mixed on site with 10 litres of potable water before application to the walls.
