### CALL FOR NOMINATION OF PERSONS TO SERVE ON THE SOUTH AFRICAN COUNCIL FOR PLANNERS

#### PLANNING PROFESSION ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2002)

Under Section 4(3) of the Planning Profession Act, 2002 (Act No. 36 of 2002), I, Angela Thokozile Didiza, Minister for Agriculture and Land Affairs, hereby invite interested persons, voluntary associations and organisations to submit nominations of suitably qualified persons to serve as member(s) of the South African Council for Planners in terms of the Planning Profession Act.

Categories of persons to constitute the Council are:

- Two planners in the full time employ of the Department of Land Affairs nominated by the Head of the Department.
- One planner in the employ of a Provincial Government from nominations by Provincial Governments.
- Two planners in the employ of the municipal sphere of government (one from a municipality which
  is mainly rural in character and the other from municipality mainly urban in character) nominated by
  municipality(ies) or an association representing planners at municipal level or representing the
  interests of local government sphere of government.
- Three planners from the planning education and training sector nominated by the Committee of University Principals, or Education and Training Institutions that offer training in planning.
- Three planners in private practice nominated by association(s) or institutions representing planners in private practice or representing the interest of planners in general.
- Three persons to represent the interest of communities who are or may be affected by planning decisions nominated by interested persons, voluntary associations and organisations.

Persons nominated must not be disqualified in terms of section 5 of the Planning Profession Act, 2002. In appointing members of the Council, the Minister will have due regard to the planning profession principles contained in section 2 of the Act, the diversity of interests and the need to ensure and promote gender, disability and other demographic representation.

Council members will hold office for a period of four years from the date of appointment as may be published in the Government Gazette.

A nomination should be accompanied by an **acceptance letter**, 6 page **curriculum vitae** and 3-page **motivation**, including the category in which the person is nominated.
