## PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO COMPULSORY SPECIFICATION FOR THE SAFETY OF MOULDED-CASE CIRCUIT BREAKERS (VC8036)

### 1 Scope

The compulsory specification VC8036 covers the safety requirements for mouldedcase circuit breakers, the main contacts of which are intended to be connected to circuits with a rated voltage not exceeding 1000V a.c. and a rated current not exceeding 125A, and with a rated service short circuit breaking capacity not exceeding 10kA.
