MARINE LIVING RESOURCES ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1998)

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Minister of Environmental Affairs and Tourism has under Section 77 of the Marine Living Resources Act, 1998 (Act No. 18 of 1998), made the Regulations as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the regulations published under Government Notice No. R. 1111 of 2 September 1998, as amended by Government Notices No. R. 27 of 14 January 2000, No. 1129 of 17 November 2000, No. R. 1344 of 8 December 2000, No. R. 1428 of 29 December 2000, No. R. 375 of 4 May 2001, No. R. 1000 of 12 October 2001, No. R. 765 of 6 June 2003, No. R. 1376 of 3 October 2003 and No. R. 1455 of 8 October 2003.

Amendment of Annexure 2 of the Regulations

2. Annexure 2 to the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for PART A, item 7, of the following item:

"7. West coast rock lobster: the holder of a—

- (a) commercial fishing permit – from 1 June to 15 November in any year, both dates inclusive; or
- (b) recreational permit – from 2 February to 14 November in any year, both dates inclusive."

3. Annexure 2 to the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for PART B, item 2, of the following item:

"2. West coast rock lobster – during the open season, a recreational permit is only valid for fishing as follows: for seven days per week as from 15 November until 31 December from 08h00 to 16h00, and from 1 January to 1 February, only on Saturdays and Sundays from 08h00 to 16h00: .

Provided that any west coast rock lobster caught in terms of a recreational permit must be landed before 16h00."
