MINISTER FOR INTELLIGENCE SERVICES**NOTICE AND INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MINISTERIAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON TRAINING FOR THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL ACADEMY OF INTELLIGENCE**

The Minister for Intelligence Services has in terms of Section 9 of the Intelligence Services Act No. 65 of 2002 established the South African National Academy of Intelligence. The academy is responsible to conduct training for members of the Intelligence Community. The Advisory Committee will be charged with two key functions namely:

- To conduct research and make recommendations to the Minister on the formulation and review of policies on training.
- Assist the head and deputy of the academy to develop a curriculum and business plan for the academy and to make recommendations to the Minister in that regard.

This advisory committee known as Ministerial Advisory Committee on Training shall govern the South African National Academy of Intelligence. Members of the committee shall be appointed on a part-time basis and on account of their special competence, experience and interest in the field of intelligence. The functions of the committee are prescribed in terms of the regulations issued in the government gazette.

Furthermore, the Minister for Intelligence Services invites all interested parties to submit nominations for the chairperson and members of the Ministerial Advisory Committee on Training. Nominees should be knowledgeable in the field of intelligence, higher education and should not hold office in any political party. Members of the committee will not receive salaries, but will be reimbursed for expense associated with serving in the Advisory Committee.

The Chairperson in particular must be a fit and proper person who is a South African citizen with experience in higher education.

The nominees will undergo a security clearance.

Anyone who wishes to nominate members of the committee should submit the following details:

- A letter containing the full name, address, telephone and fax numbers, e-mail address, motivation for the nominations(s).
- Curriculum vitae of the nominee, explaining his/her suitability for appointment.
- A brief statement of consent signed by the nominee.
- Names of at least three contactable referees who know the nominees.

NB: NO NOMINATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED UNLESS ENTIRE ABOVE DETAILS ARE ADHERED TO. CLOSING DATE FOR NOMINATIONS IS 24 FEBRUARY 2004.
