NATIONAL ROUTE 2: NORTH COAST TOLL ROAD (UMDLOTI TO MARIEDAL): TONGAAT, MVOTI, MTUNZINI, MANDINI AND DOKODWENI TOLL PLAZAS: PUBLICATION OF THE AMOUNTS OF TOLL FOR THE VARIOUS CATEGORIES OF MOTOR VEHICLES, AND THE DATE UPON AND THE TIME AT WHICH THE TOLL TARIFFS SHALL BECOME PAYABLE

The Head of the Department hereby, in terms of section 27 (3) (c) of The South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act, 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998) [the Act], makes known that the amounts of toll which may be levied in terms of section 27 (1) (b) of the Act at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas (located on the North Coast Toll Road, declared in terms of Government Notice No's. 371 of 1990 and 17112 of 1996), and the date upon and time at which the amounts of toll shall become payable, have been determined by the Minister of Transport in terms of section 27 (3) (a) of the Act and that the said amounts shall be levied under section 27 (3) (b) and (d) thereof, as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS: 1.

- "Motor vehicle" means an entity comprising of one or more mechanically 1.1 powered units with or without any trailer(s) physically joined by means of tow bars, tow ropes or mechanical articulation, and includes
 - a) a motor cycle:
 - b) a motor tricycle;
 - c) a motor car;
 - d) a vehicle which has pedals and a mechanically powered units as an integral part thereof or attached thereto and which is designed or adapted to be propelled by means of either such pedals or such mechanical unit or both: and
 - e) a light delivery vehicle (a bakkie)
- "Motor cycle" means a motor vehicle that has two wheels and includes 1.2 anv such vehicle having a sidecar attached thereto.
- 1.3 "Motor tricycle" means a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle with a sidecar, which has three wheels and which is designed to be driven by means of the type of controls usually fitted to a motorcycle.
- 1.4 "Motor car" means a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle or a motor tricycle, designed or adapted solely or principally for the conveyance of persons not exceeding sixteen (16) in number.
- "Light delivery vehicle" means a motor vehicle designed or adapted for the 1.5 conveyance of persons and freight with a tare not exceeding one comma five (1.5) ton and with no heavy axle as defined in paragraph 1.7 hereunder.
- "Axle" means a device or set of devices, whether continuous across the width 1.6 of the vehicle or not, about which the wheels of the vehicle rotate and which is so placed that, when the vehicle is travelling straight ahead, the vertical center-lines of such wheels are in one vertical plane at right angles to the longitudinal center-line of such vehicle.
- "Heavy axle" means an axle the wheels of which are fitted with tyres of a 1.7 size(bead seat diameter) greater than 406,4 millimetres (16 inches), or an axle with more than two (2) wheels irrespective of tyre size, but excluding any axle of a motor cycle, a motor tricycle or a motor car.
- "Light vehicle" means a motor vehicle, other than heavy vehicles as defined 1.8 hereunder.
- 1.9 "Heavy vehicle" means a motor vehicle with at least one heavy axle and/ or a motor vehicle exceeding a tare of one comma five (1,5) ton.
- 1.10 "Abnormal vehicle" means a motor vehicle exceeding the legal dimensions as described in the Road Traffic Act, 1989, or in any other law.

1.11 "Trailer" means a vehicle which is not self-propelled and which is designed or adapted to be drawn by a motor vehicle but does not include a sidecar attached to a motor cycle.

2. CLASSIFICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES:

Class I: Light vehicles:

Light vehicles are motor vehicles, other than heavy vehicles as defined hereunder, with or without a trailer, and include motor evaluations are and light deliver websites.

cycles, motor cars and light delivery vehicles.

Class II: Medium heavy vehicles

Medium heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with two axles.

Class III: Large heavy vehicles

Large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with three or four axles.

Class IV: Extra large heavy vehicles

Extra large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles with five or more

axles.

2. AMOUNTS OF TOLL:

2.1 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the **Umdloti** and **Ballito Interchanges** (or any part thereof) is payable at the **Tongaat Mainline Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: **R5.00**CLASS II: **R10.00**CLASS III: **R14.00**CLASS IV: **R19.00**

2.2 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the **Ballito** and **Tongaat Interchanges** or between the **Umdloti** and **Tongaat Interchanges** (or any part thereof) is payable at the **Tongaat Ramp Toll Plazas** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R2.50 CLASS II: R5.00 CLASS III: R7.00 CLASS IV: R9.50

2.3 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the **Ballito** and **MR105 Interchanges** (or any part thereof) is payable at the **Mvoti Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R5.50 CLASS II: R15.00 CLASS III: R19.00 CLASS IV: R29.00 2.4 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the R102 at Mariedal and the MR105 Interchanges at New Guelderland (or any part thereof) is payable at the Mtunzini Mainline Toll Plaza and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R20.00
CLASS II: R39.00
CLASS III: R47.00
CLASS IV: R62.00

2.5 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the Mtunzini Interchange and Road: MR496 (or any part thereof) is payable at the Mtunzini Northern Ramp Toll Plaza and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R3.50 CLASS II: R7.00 CLASS III: R8.50 CLASS IV: R13.00

2.6 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the **Mtunzini** and **MR105 Interchanges**, (or any part thereof) is payable at the **Mtunzini Southern Ramp Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R16.50 CLASS II: R32.00 CLASS III: R38.50 CLASS IV: R51.00

2.7 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the Mandini and MR105 Interchanges (or any part thereof) is payable at the Mandini Southern Ramp Toll Plaza and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R3.00 CLASS II: R6.00 CLASS IV: R7.00 CLASS IV: R9.50

2.8 The amounts of toll for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the **Dokodweni** and **MR105** Interchanges (or any part thereof) is payable at the **Dokodweni Southern Ramp Toll Plaza** and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R8.00 CLASS II: R17.00 CLASS III: R19.00 CLASS IV: R26.00

4 LOCAL COMMUTER DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE MVOTI TOLL PLAZA:

4.1 Local Commuter Discounts on the toll tariffs, for all classes of motor vehicles and as described in Paragraph No: 3.3 above, are granted to registered bona fide residents of Stanger on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Mvoti Toll Plaza for the usage of that section of the North Coast Toll Road between the Ballito and MR105 Interchanges and shall be as follows:

CLASS I: R1.50
CLASS II: R4.00
CLASS III: R5.50
CLASS IV: R8.50

- 5 FREQUENT USER DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE TONGAAT, MVOT!, MTUNZINI, MANDINI AND DOKODWEN! TOLL PLAZAS:
- 5.1 Frequent User Discounts on the toll tariffs, for Class I motor vehicles only, are granted on successful application to the appointed Toll Operator at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas. The following discounts are offered when a valid "Frequent User Card", approved by The South African National Roads Agency Limited, is tendered for payment at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas for the usage of the North Coast Toll Road (or a part thereof):
 - (a) for **20 to 39 trips** per single card, per plaza, during a calendar month **20% discount**.
 - (b) for **40 and more trips** per single card, per plaza, during a calendar month **40% discount**.
- 6 HEAVY VEHICLE DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE TONGAAT, MVOTI, MTUNZINI, MANDINI AND DOKODWENI TOLL PLAZAS:
- 6.1 A discount of **five percent (5%)** on the toll tariffs, for **Class II**, **III and IV** (**heavy vehicles**) only is granted, irrespective of the number of trips, when a valid **Credit Card** (**Visa- or Master Card**), or a valid **Fleet Management Card**; is tendered for payment at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas for the usage of the North Coast Toll Road (or a part thereof). This discount will, however, not be granted to commuters that qualify for the Local Commuter Discounts, available at the Mvoti Toll Plaza and as described in Paragraph No. 4 above.

- 7. INFORMATION REGARDING DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE AT THE TONGAAT-, MVOTI-, MTUNZINI-, MANDINI-; AND DOKODWENI TOLL PLAZAS:
- 7.1 Information, documentation and applications forms regarding available discounts-, and related costs are available at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas.
- 8. The North Coast Toll Road shall be open to traffic for 24 hours a day.
- 9. The date upon and the time at which the said amounts of toll shall become payable at the Tongaat, Mvoti, Mtunzini, Mandini and Dokodweni Toll Plazas shall be March 1, 2004 at 00H:00.
