INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION ACT, 71 OF 2002

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF A PERSON TO BE APPOINTED AS DEPUTY CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION OF SOUTH AFRICA

The International Trade Administration Act established the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa. This Commission has jurisdiction throughout the Republic. The Commission investigates and evaluates applications with regard to alleged dumping, subsidized exports, safeguard duties and amendment of customs duties in the Common Customs Area. The Commission recommends the issuing of permits or certificates in terms of rebate and drawback provisions of the Customs and Excise Act. The Commission must monitor, review, report to the Minister of Trade and Industry and when appropriate, advises the Minister in respect of, any matter referred to it that affects or may affect trade and industry in the Republic.

The Chief Commissioner is the Chief Executive Officer of the Commission and will be responsible for the general administration of the Commission. The Deputy Chief Commissioner will perform functions as assigned by the Chief Commissioner among others:

- To provide strategic direction to the tariff investigations, trade remedies and import and export directorates.
- To coordinate and manage the legal services and research components.

- To develop and manage an effective policy development mechanism.

The Deputy Chief Commissioner must perform the functions of the Chief Commissioner whenever the Chief Commissioner is unable to perform her or his functions or the office of the Chief Commissioner is vacant.

To be eligible for appointment, and to continue to hold office as a member of the Commission a person must:

- Be ordinarily resident in South Africa
- Have suitable qualifications and experience in economics, accounting, law, commerce, agriculture, industry or public affairs
- Not be an office bearer of any party, movement, organization or body of a partisan political nature
- Not be an unrehabilitated insolvent
- Not have been found mentally unfit by order of a competent court
- Not have been convicted of an offence committed after the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa took effect, and sentenced to imprisonment without the option of a fine.

I, Alexander Erwin, Minister of Trade and Industry, hereby call for the nominations of persons who comply with the abovementioned requirements.

Nominations, accompanied by a motivation, the curriculum vitae of the nominee and a letter of consent indicating the availability of the nominee to be appointed as Deputy Chief Commissioner if selected, should be forwarded to:
