### CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS TO THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT BOARD

#### **CLOSING DATE: 22 APRIL 2004**

In terms of the Construction Industry Development Board Act, 2000 (Act No. 38 of 2000), I, Stella N Sigcau, the Minister of Public Works, hereby call for nominations for members of the Construction Industry Development Board.

Nominations are necessary for appointment of members to the Construction Industry Development Board for its second term of office. The period of office of members will be three years calculated from the date of the appointment. The Construction Industry Development Board will meet at least four times per annum and is supported by a Chief Executive Officer and staff.

Nominees must be competent persons with leadership qualities and the ability to contribute to the strategic direction of the Construction Industry Development Board in the interests of construction industry development.

Nominees must possess expertise and knowledge, preferably relating to any of the following areas:

- (a) construction;
- (b) Public and private sector clients of the industry;
- (c) Black economic empowerment and the emerging industry;
- (d) Labour/industrial relations;
- (e) Built environment professions;
- (f) Education, training and research
- (g) Project financing;
- (h) Construction procurement;
- (i) Other related areas (e.g. suppliers).

Experience in finance, law, economic or information technology and the ability to network on a national or international basis will be an advantage.

Each nomination must be in writing and must contain the following information:

- (a) The name and address of the nominating person or organisation;
- (b) The name, address and identity number of the nominee;
- (c) A declaration by the nominee that he or she is qualified to serve on the Construction Industry Development Board in terms of section 6 of the Construction Industry Development Board Act, 2000\*;
- (d) Motivation for the appointment of the nominee to the Construction Industry Development Board (not exceeding one page);
- (e) A short curriculum vitae of the nominee (not exceeding two pages).

In constituting the Construction Industry Development Board, due cognisance will be taken of the need for appointments to achieve a balance of expertise and knowledge of the construction industry, whilst broadly reflecting the race, gender and geographic composition of the Republic.
