## STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION FOR ONGOING TRADE NEGOTIATIONS

It is hereby announced, for general information, that a consultative process is underway within the National Economic Development and Labour Council (NEDLAC) concerning a number of trade negotiations between South Africa, in conjunction with other members of the Southern African Customs Union (Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia and Swaziland) and third countries. The current consultative agenda includes the following negotiations:

- 1. Free Trade Area (FTA) negotiations between the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) and the United States of America;
- 2. FTA negotiations between SACU and the European Free Trade Association (EFTA);
- 3. Fixed preferences negotiations, as the first phase of eventual FTA negotiations, between SACU and the Common Market of the Southern Cone (MERCOSUR);
- 4. The review of the Trade, Development and Cooperation Agreement (TDCA) between South Africa and the European Union (EU), as foreseen in articles 18 and 103 of the TDCA; and
- 5. Consultations, in terms of article 22 of the TDCA, between South Africa and the EU with regard to the recent enlargement of the EU.

NEDLAC is the statutory body, created by the NEDLAC Act 35 of 1994, to facilitate consultations and consensus among others on trade matters between Government, Business, Labour, and community organizations. Sector Task Teams have been established to facilitate the consultative process concerning the above-mentioned negotiations. This ensures that positions are deliberated and cleared at sector level before these are transmitted to Government. The Task Teams, with the respective conveners, are listed below.
