NOTICE 1130 OF 2004



INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY OF SOUTH AFRICA APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF BROADCASTING LICENCE CONDITIONS: KAYA FM

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice, in terms of section 52(2)(a) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, Act No 153 of 1993 ("the Act"), that it is has received an application from Kaya FM for the amendment of its broadcasting licence in terms of section 52(1)(c) of the Act.
- 2. This application is available for inspection by any interested parties during the Authority's normal office hours.
- 3. According to the applicant, the proposed amendment will result in an increase in the station's coverage area with the establishment of additional transmitters at specific sites as set out in section 3 of the application. The applicant has provided the Authority with three options with regard to the establishment of additional transmitters, as set out in the Schedule below.
- 4. Interested persons are hereby invited to make written representations on the proposed amendments to the Authority by 6 July 2004. Interested persons who make such written representations to the Authority must simultaneously indicate whether they require an opportunity to make oral representations to the Authority on the proposed amendments. Any interested person who makes written representations on the proposed amendments to the Authority must, at the time of doing so, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that he or she has delivered a copy of such representations to Kaya FM by hand, or has sent a copy of such representations to Kaya FM by registered mail or by facsimile.
- 5. Kaya FM shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the proposed amendments, and any such written response must be lodged with the Authority within sixty (60) days of the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*. Kaya FM must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such representations by registered mail or by facsimile, to the relevant person having made such written representations.

SCHEDULE

Option 1

The applicant has proposed the establishment of additional Kaya FM transmitters at the following sites for the following frequencies:

Dullstroom, at the transmitter power 1kw yielding 10 kw ERP - 97.3 MHz Heidelburg, at the transmitter power 0.05 kw yielding 0.1 ERP-89.9 MHz, Hoedspruit, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 18 kw ERP- 93.2 MHz Middelburg, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 11 kw ERP-106.4 MHz Nelspruit, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 10 kw ERP-99.43 MHz Nylstroom, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 10 kw ERP-89.7 MHz Potgietersrus, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 10 kw ERP-89.7MHz Pretoria, at the transmitter power 3 kw yielding 33 kw ERP-98.9 MHz Rustenburg, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 11 kw ERP-97.4 MHz Thabazimbi, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 11 kw ERP-97.4 MHz Tzaneen, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 12 kw ERP-97.6 MHz Welverdiend, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 20 kw ERP-103.7 MHz

The applicant has stated that its preferred option is Option 1. However, the applicant has added further that if the Authority, for whatever reason, finds that this option cannot be approved then it asks that the regulator consider a second and third option in lieu of Option 1.

Option 2

The applicant has proposed the establishment of additional Kaya FM transmitters at the following sites:

Heidelburg, at the transmitter power 0.05 kw yielding 0.1 kw ERP- 89.9 MHz Nylstroom, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 4 kw ERP-99.4 MHz Pretoria, at the transmitter power 3 kw yielding 33 kw ERP-98.9MHz Rustenburg, at the transmitter power 0.5 kw yielding 4 kw ERP- 90.7 MHz Thabazimbi, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 11 kw ERP- 97.4 MHz Welverdiend, at the transmitter power 1 kw yielding 20Kw ERP

Option 3

The applicant has proposed the establishment of additional transmitters at the following sites, for the listed frequencies:

Pretoria, 3 kw transmitter power yielding 33 kw ERP-98.9 MHz Heidelburg, at the transmitter power 0.05 kw yielding 0.1 kw ERP-89.9 MHz Welverdiend, at the transmitter power 1kW yielding 20 kw ERP.
