INVITATION BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE TRANSPORT APPEAL TRIBUNAL ESTABLISHED IN TERMS OF THE TRANSPORT APPEAL TRIBUNAL ACT, 1998

A Transport Appeal Tribunal consisting of not more than nine members will be established by the Minister of Transport to consider appeals noted in terms of national land transport legislation and the Cross-Border Road Transport Act, 1998 (Act No 4 of 1998) and for matters connected therewith.

Members are appointed for a period not exceeding three years and are remunerated for each day or part of a day in any month in which the duties of the Tribunal were performed.

All interested parties are therefore invited to nominate suitable candidates to serve on the Transport Appeal Tribunal. Nominees must have knowledge of, or experience in financial, economic, commercial, legal or other matters relating to the function of the Tribunal.

Note: In terms of the National Land Transport Principles and Policy under Chapter 2 of the National Land Transport Transitional Act, 2000 (Act No 22 of 2000), members of the Transport Appeal Tribunal must be impartial, have no direct financial or business interest in any sector of the public transport industry, and may not decide or adjudicate on a matter in which they have such an interest.

Now, therefore, I, Jeff Radebe, Minister of Transport, hereby in terms of section 4(2)(b)(i) of the Transport Appeal Tribunal Act, No 39 of 1998, call for the nominations of persons who comply with the stipulated requirements.

After the closing date of the nominations, the names of the shortlisted candidates will be published in the Gazette where after all interested parties may lodge any representation within a period of five working days. All representation lodged will be taken into account when making the final appointments.

Nominees will be expected to disclose to the Director-General: Transport particulars of all registrable financial interests and will be subjected to a security clearance.
