**ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LOUWNA/COETZERSDAM WATER USER ASSOCIATION,
MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS OF VRYBURG, NORTH WEST PROVINCE, WATER
MANAGEMENT AREA NUMBER 10**

I, Buyelwa Patience Sonjica, Minister of Water Affairs and Forestry, hereby in terms of section 92(1) of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No 36 of 1998), declare that-

- (a) the Louwna/Coetzersdam Water User Association is established;
- (b) the Association's name is the Louwna/Coetzersdam Water User Association;
- (c) the area of operation of the Louwna/Coetzersdam Water User Association includes all properties in respect of which any person is entitled to use water (surface and underground water) by virtue of entitlements in terms of section 22(1) of the Act as follows:

(i) Sub-area 1:

The Northern boundary of the farms Summerfield No. 676, Birnamwood No. 475 and Long Valley No. 474 in the West up to the farm Nelspos No. 999 in the East;

The Eastern boundary of the farm Nelspos No. 999 in the North up to the farm Mooifontein No. 603 in the South;

The Southern boundaries of farms commencing from the farm Mooifontein No. 603 in the East up to the farm Waaihoek No. 626 in the West;

The Western boundaries of the farms commencing from the farm Waaihoek No. 626 in the South up to the farm Summerfield No. 676 in the North and the Western boundary of the farm Long Valley No. 474H;


Sub-area 2:

The farms Oorloop No. 589, Vogelpan No. 610, Goedgevonden No. 659, Welcome No. 1024 and Vicedale Ranch No. 588; and

- (ii) any other water resource situated outside the area described in paragraph (c)(i) above, which water resource and accompanying area the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry or the responsible authority may require the Association to control,

which is situated in Water Management Area number 10 in the North West Province; and

- (d) the constitution of the Louwna/Coetzersdam Water User Association has been approved.
