2. SUMMARY OF EVALUATION PROCESS

On 17/07/2004, I as the Minister of Trade and Industry endorsed the recommendation of the Strategic Industrial Projects Adjudication Committee meeting of 08th July 2004 not to approve the application of Nampak Products limited – Gravure press as a Strategic Industrial Project (SIP) in terms of Section 12G of the Income Tax Act (Act No. 58 of 1962), as amended and the relevant Regulations. The project failed to achieve minimum points required as set out in the criteria in terms of Section 12G of the Income Tax Act, and the SIP regulations. The project only scored 3 points and was therefore not approved as a strategic industrial project.
