 renewal of its community sound broadcasting licence in terms of section 44(1).

- 4. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof must simultaneously indicate whether they also require an opportunity to make oral representations to the Authority.

Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, shall at the time of lodgement furnish proof to the satisfaction of the Authority that a copy of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr AM Dladla, Station Manager, Greater Middelburg Community Radio, Stand 247, Mhluzi, Middelburg 1053 or sent by registered post to PO Box 28 Mhluzi, Middelburg, 1053 or faxed to (013) 242 1803.
- 6. Greater Middelburg Community Radio shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the proposed renewal, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within sixty (60) days of the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. Greater Middelburg Community Radio must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
