SOUTH AFRICAN QUALIFICATIONS AUTHORITY ACT, 1995 (ACT NO. 58 OF 1995) AS AMENDED

CALLING FOR THE NOMINATION OF PERSONS TO SERVE AS MEMBERS ON THE THIRD SOUTH AFRICAN QUALIFICATIONS AUTHORITY FOR THE PERIOD 27 OCTOBER 2004 UNTIL 26 OCTOBER 2007

- I, Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor, Minister of Education, in consultation with the Minister of Labour, Mr M. M. S. Mdladlana, hereby give notice in terms of Section 4(4) of the South African Qualifications Authority Act, 1995 (Act No. 58 of 1995) as amended, hereafter referred to as "the SAQA Act", and invite nominations of persons who, on account of their experience and expertise in matters relating to the functions of the Authority, may be suitable candidates for appointment as members of the Third Authority.
- 2. This Government Notice is concerned with the procedures for nominating all members of the Authority, except the Chairperson and the Executive Officer. Members of the Authority will be appointed for a three-year period, namely 27 October 2004 until 26 October 2007. The post of members of the Authority is not a full-time appointment.

Nominations for membership of the Authority

3. In terms of Section 4(3) of the SAQA Act a number of bodies or organisations are requested to nominate persons "who, on account of their experience and expertise in matters relating to the functions of the Authority may be suitable candidates for

appointment as members of the Authority", and "due recognition is to be given to the principle of representivity".

- 4. Nominations for membership of the Authority should reach the address given in paragraph 8 by 24 September 2004, and should enclose a *curriculum vitae* and a letter of consent signed by each nominee.

Recommendation of candidates for discretionary appointment by the Minister

Any body or organisation whose interests are not otherwise covered by the SAQA Act, and that wishes to recommend a candidate for appointment by the Minister, is invited to submit such a recommendation, together with a curriculum vitae and a letter of consent from the candidate. Recommendations marked "Discretionary Appointments to SAQA", should be received at the address given in paragraph 8 below by 24 September 2004. However, it must be clearly stated that I am not obliged to restrict myself only to recommendations received in terms of this Notice, but that I am also entitled to make discretionary appointments over and above recommendations received by means of this Notice.
