



REGULATIONS FOR THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE

The Minister for Safety and Security has, under section 24 and 48 of the South African Police Service Act, 1995 (Act No. 68 of 1995), made the regulations in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these regulations, "the Regulations" mean the South African Reserve Police Service Regulations, 2002, promulgated by Government Notice No. R. 334 of 22 March 2002.

Insertion of new Regulation

2. The Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 5 of the following regulation:

"5A COMPENSATION

If a reservist voluntarily performs duty in the Service or undergoes training and is injured in the execution of such duty or during such training or as a result of such duty or training, causing the permanent disablement or death of the reservist, —

- (a) the Compensation Commissioner may determine the percentage of permanent disablement of the reservist in accordance with the provisions of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993 (Act No. 130 of 1993); and
- (b) the National Treasury may grant, out of state funds, such compensation and other benefits to the reservist or his or her next-of-kin to which the reservist or his or her next-of-kin, as the case may be, would have been entitled, had the reservist been an "employee" as defined in the said Act.

Short title and commencement

3. These regulations shall be called the South African Reserve Police Service Amendment Regulations, 2004, and are deemed to have come into operation on 22 March 2002.
