Knitted cotton fabrics, impregnated, coated, covered or laminated with plastics (excluding polyvinyl chloride or polyurethane), of a mass not exceeding 200 g/m<sup>2</sup> classifiable under tariff subheading 5903.90.40 for the manufacture of made up articles of tariff subheading 6307.90.90 for medical use.
