THE PRESIDENCY

AMENDMENT OF THE WARRANT RELATING TO THE ORDER OF MAPUNGUBWE

WHEREAS "The Order of Mapungubwe" was instituted by a Warrant on 6 December 2002 in Government Gazette No 24155;

AND WHEREAS the conditions for the award of the Order, as well as the Rules and Regulations pertaining thereto, are contained in the aforesaid Warrant.

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby, In terms of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 9(i) of the Regulations, amend the said Warrant by-

1. Substituting section 1 with the following section:

(a) The Order may be awarded to South African citizens in the following categories

(i) Order of Mapungubwe in Platinum

To South African citizens whose exceptional and unique achievements in the international arena have served the interest of the Republic of South Africa.

(ii) Order of Mapungubwe in Gold

To South African citizens whose exceptional achievements in the international arena have served the interests of the Republic of South Africa.

(iii) Order of Mapungubwe in Silver

To South African citizens whose excellent achievements in the international arena have served the interest of the Republic of South Africa.

(iv) Order of Mapungubwe in Bronze


To South African citizens whose outstanding achievements in the international arena have served the interests of the Republic of South Africa.

2. Substituting section 9 with the following section:

The Conferment of the Order shall not entitle recipients to any individual precedence, rank, style or title, but the said recipients shall be entitled to indicate their investiture with the relevant category of the Order by the use of the following post-nominal letters:

Order of Mapungubwe	:	Platinum	OMP
Order of Mapungubwe	:	Gold	OMG
Order of Mapungubwe	:	Silver	OMS
Order of Mapungubwe	:	Bronze	OMB
