## EXTRACT FROM THE MINES AND WORKS REGULATIONS

(Sunday Labour Permission)

"Reg. 3.3 Every permission or a copy thereof granted by the Government Mining Engineer under section 9 of the Act shall be posted up in a

Suitable place at the mine or works."

"Reg. 3.8.1 (Renewals of notice). So often as any posted notice or copy thereof become defaced, obliterated or destroyed it shall be

renewed with all reasonable despatch."

"Reg. 3.8.2 (Interfering with notices). No unauthorised person shall remove or deface any of the beforementioned notices or copies thereof"
