Transferring Department	Agriculture (Vote 26)
Purpose	Drought relief to farmers in identified areas.
Measurable objectives/outputs	Financial assistance in the purchasing and transporting of fodder at well as the repair of old and drilling of new boreholes in identified drought stricken areas for stock purposes.
Conditions	Implementation of the drought relief scheme and monthly reporting by provincial Departments of Agriculture on the actual spending according to the agreed framework on drought assistance.
Allocation criteria	Based on surveys made by provincial Departments of Agriculture and the national Department of Agriculture of the affected areas.
Reasons not incorporated into equitable sbare	Special drought relief allocation by Parliament.
Monitoring mechanisms	Regular inspection and monitoring by the national Department of Agriculture and monthly reporting by the provincial Departments of Agriculture on the actual spending.
Past performance	New grant.

Payment schedule	Payments to be made on 5 January 2005 .
Capacity and preparedness of the transferring department	Policy frameworks, monitoring and reporting mechanisms are in place.

Land Distribution: Ale	xandra Urban Renewal Project
Transferring Department	Land Affairs (Vote 30)
Purpose	To contribute towards the purchase of land for the relocation and settlement of Alexandra residents and other qualifying beneficiaries.
Measurable objectives/outputs	 To contribute towards the acquisition of 269,71 hectares of land for human settlement purposes. To provide for the settlement of approximately 32 000 people whc qualify for housing subsidies on the purchased land.
Conditions	 The funds are to be used for the sole purpose of acquisition of lanc for settlement only. The Gauteng Department of Housing will account to the national Department of Land Affairs and lawful state organs on the expenditure of the funds. The funds must be used in full before the end of the financial year. The Gauteng Department of Housing must provide a written repor on the expenditure of the funds and a list of beneficiaries for the land bought.
Allocation criteria	 Needs based on the total budget allocated for land reform in the national Department of Land Affairs. Based on competing land reform programmes to be implemented.
Monitoring mechanisms	 Monthly reports as per the Division of Revenue Act, 2004. Quarterly reports as per the approved format. Biannual site visits to assess progress.
Past performance	New grant.
Projected life	The project will be completed in the 2007/08 financial year depending on the request for funding by the Gauteng Department of Housing.
Payment schedule	Annual payment on 15 December 2004.
Capacity and preparedness of the transferring department	 The national Department of Land Affairs to ensure that the funds are used for land acquisition in terms of the standard agreement and that the land is used for resettlement in terms of the land redistribution programme.
	 Ensure that the land will benefit beneficiaries in terms of Act 126 of 1993. Ongoing monitoring for the land use until land has been fully allocated to beneficiaries.
