#### Key criteria:

- The Board, when viewed collectively, must represent a broad cross-section of the historically disadvantaged persons of the Republic
- The Board should be reasonably reflective of the gender composition of the historically disadvantaged persons and be fairly representative of the various provinces of the Republic
- The Board should possess expertise and organization in the fields of amongst others, Law, Economics, Business Practice, Development mance Practice, Capital Markets and Finance. Suitable nominees must be capable of promoting the objectives of the NEF and the Broad-Based BEE Act and should the core possess relevant qualifications and appropriate knowledge / experience in at least one of the aforemental dields.

- The Board should comprise an appropriate mix evexecutive and non-executive trustees, and must consist of not less than 5, out to more than than 1, trustees.
