KENNISGEWING INGEVOLGE ARTIKEL 33(3)(bA) VAN DIE WET OP VETERINÊRE EN PARA-VETERINÊRE BEROEPE 1982 (WET 19 VAN 1982)

Besonderhede rakenda onderstaande persone na behoorlike ondersoek na hulle gedrag deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Veterinêre Raad wat een onprofessionele, onbehoorlike of skandaleuse gedrag skuldig bevind is, word hierby vir algemene Infiting bokendgemaak:

D94/3593 Dr Bhekinkhosini Ndebele	Posbus 27039 Sunnyside 0132	Skandellkegedrag: (a) Hy het 'n kollega in sy hoedanigheid as staatsveearts genader om ses (6) veterinêre gesondheidssertifikate te leken sonder om die feit dat hy reeds die Staatsveeartskantoor genader het bekend te maak en sy kollega bedrieglik mislei het in die verband; (b) Hy het vier (4) inentingssertifikate bedrieglik verander ten spyte daarvan dat hy deur 'n kollega ingelyk is dat indien 'n verkeerde etiket gebruik is, 'n getekende verklaring van die veerarts wat die dier ingeget het en oorspronklik die sertifikaat geteken het met aanduiding van Wetten entsetof wanneer en deur wie verrels word. (c) Hy het 'n kollega mislei toe hy hom gevra het om ses (6) veterinêre gesondheidssertifikate te teken on aan te dui dat die ses (6) diere se inentingsrekords in orde was. Terwyl dit nie die geval was nie; en (d) Hy het nagelaat om bohoorlike rekords van die inentings van die ses (6) diere wat met voorafgaando gesondheidssertifikate betrekking het, te hou.	Registrasie om as veerarts te praktiseer opgeskort vir ses (6) maande.  Vonnis opgeskort vir 'n periode van drie (3) jaar op die volgende voorwaardes: (a) Dat hy nie weer skuldig bevind word aan 'n soortgelyke oorreding gedurende die tydperk van opskorting; en (b) Dat hy slegs gedurende die tydperk van opskorting sy professionele dienste mag lever onder die toesig van 'n behoorlike aangewysde veerarts wie twee jaarliks aan die Readrapporteer met belrekking tot sy werkverrigting / prestasie wat verband hou met die oorreding.	16 Julie 2004

D94/3593 Dr Bhekinkhosi Ndebele	P O Box 27039 Sunnyside 0132	Disgraceful conduct in that (a) He approached a State Veterinarian, to have six (6) veterinary health certificates countersigned without disclosing the fact that he had attempted to have them countersigned by the State Veterinary Offices In Pretoria advising the colleague fraudulently that he had acquired the dogs too late to make it to the State Veterinary Offices; (b) He fraudulently altered four (4) vaccination certificates by merely affixing different adhesive labels for previous vaccination dates despite being advised by his colleague that if an incorrect label had been used, a signed affidavit by the veterinarian who vaccinated the animal and originally signed the certificates should accompany the new vaccination records with clear indication of which vaccine had been administered when and by whom; (c) He misled a colleague when requesting him to sign six (6) veterinary health certificates by advising him that the vaccination records of the respective six (6) animals were in order whilst the records were not in order; and (d) Dr Ndebele failed to keep proper records of the vaccinations of the six (6) animals pertaining to the aforementioned veterinary health certificates.	Registration to practise as a veterinarian is suspended for six (6) months.  Whole sentence suspended for a period of three (3) years on the following conditions;  (a) He is not found guilty of a similar offence committed during the period of suspension; and  (b) He may only during the period of suspension perform his professional duties under the supervision of an appropriately designated veterinarian who is required to report to Council on a bi-annual basis, on his performance in matters relating to the conviction.	16 July 2004
