# SKILLS DEVELOPMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 97 OF 1998) REGULATIONS REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SECTOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITIES

I, Membathisi Mphumzi, Shepherd Mdladlana, Minister of Labour, after consultation with the National Skills Authority, hereby, in terms of section 36, read with section 9(1) of the Skills Development Act, 1998 (Act No. 97 of 1998) make the regulations in the Schedule.

#### **SCHEDULE**

### **Definitions**

1. In these regulations "the Regulations," means the Regulations Regarding *the* Establishment of Sector Education and Training Authorities published under the Government Notice No. R **1082 of 7** September **1999**.

### Amendment of regulation 3 of the Regulations

- 2. Regulation 3 of the Regulations is hereby amended-
  - (a) by the substitution for subregulation (3) of the following subregulation:
  - "(3) Subject to subregulation (4) and regulation 4, [A] **a** certificate of establishment as a SETA is valid for a period of 60 months **from** the date on which it was issued."
  - (b) by the addition after subregulation (3) of the following subregulations:
  - "(4) The Minister may, after consultation with the National Skills Authority and by notice in the Gazette, extend the period of 60 months' referred to in subregulation (3).
  - "(5) The provisions of the Public Finance Management Act apply to the period of extension contemplated in subregulation (4)."
