#### **NOTICE 261 OF 2005**

#### PRESS RELEASE

PROPOSED FEES FOR SCUBA DIVER AND SCUBA DIVER BUSINESS PERMITS WITHIN AN MARINE PROTECTED AREA ("MPA")

Marine Protected Area Regulations as promulgated under Section 43 of the Marine Living Resources Act, Act 18 of 1998, Government Gazette No.'s 26430, 26431, 26433 state that:

"....no person may operate or attempt to operate a SCUBA diving business in the Marine Protected Area except on the authority of a SCUBA diving business permit"

And Government Gazette No.'s 26430, 26431, 26432 and 26433 state that:

"...no person may SCUBA dive or attempt to SCUBA dive in the Marine Protected Area except on the authority of a SCUBA diving permit".

Anchor Environmental Consultants were contracted to provide the Department with recommendations as to an appropriate permitting procedure and fees. The report, "Recommendations for MPA diving and dive operator permit systems", was informed **by** way of an extensive public consultation process conducted **by** the Consultants.
