APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND OBJECTIONS THERETO

SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 7B OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)

The undermentioned person has applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of his heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

1. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

ARMS: Per fess Gules and Azure, a pale counterchanged charged with three mullets Or, two and one (for Sutherland) and as many cross crosslets fitchy Or, one and two (for Duffus-Sutherland), in chief a label Argent, each of the three branches charged with an ermine spot, 'at nombril point an escutcheon Argent, charged with a cross flory Gules, voided of the field within an orlé of twelve escutcheons azure, each charged with five plates in saltire (for Albergaria).

CREST: A chapeau Gules, 'turned up'ermine thereupon a lion Argent, statant guardant, langued and armed Gules, crowned with an ancient crown consisting of a circlet heightened by four fleurs-de-lis Or, vulned in his chest and bleeding, 'grasping with his dexter forepaw a cross crosslet fitchy Or.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Gules seme of suns in splendour Or doubled Or.

SUPPORTERS: Two Scottish deerhounds Proper ducally gorged, pendant there from a chain Or.

SPECIAL COMPARTMENT: A green mound semé of forget-me-not flowers (*Myosotis palustris*) proper.

MOTTOES: Above the crest: EN AVANT SANS PEUR

Below the shield: NE OBLIVISCARIS

2. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

BADGE 1: Within a strap Gules, buckled and lined Or, charged with the motto NE OBLIVISCARIS in letters Or, a human heart Gules, charged with a droplet Or, crowned with an ancient crown consisting of a circlet heightened by four fleurs-de-lis Or.

3. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

BADGE 2: In saltire a pomegranate slipped and leaved proper, seeded Gules, and a thistle proper, enfiled by a ducal coronet Or.

4. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

BADGE 3: A stag head caboshed and attired, between the antlers a sun in splendour, all Or.

5. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

BANNER: Per fess Gules and Azure, a pale counterchanged charged with three mullets Or, two and one and as many cross crosslets fitchy Or, one and two, in chief a label Argent, each of the three branches charged with an ermine spot, at nombril point an escutcheon Argent, charged with a cross flory Gules, voided of the field within an orlé of twelve escutcheons Azure, each charged with five plates in saltire.

6. **APPLICANT:** Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria, Baron of Greencastle, Lord of the Manors Caher and Brierfield (H4/3/4/680)

STANDARD: In the hoist the arms of Mario Stefano Marco Teixeira de Albergaria and in the fly, per fess Gules and Azure, semé of suns in splendour Or, between two transverse bends Argent, bearing the motto EN AVANT SANS PEUR in letters Azure, in the first compartment his crest namely a chapeau Gules, turned up ermine thereupon a lion Argent, statant guardant, langued and armed Gules,
