APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HERALDIC REPRESENTATIONS AND OBJECTIONS THERETO

SECTIONS 7, 7A AND 7B OF THE HERALDRY ACT, 1962 (ACT NO. 18 OF 1962)

The undermentioned bodies and persons have applied in terms of section 7 of the Heraldry Act, 1962 (Act No. 18 of 1962), for the registration of their heraldic representations. Anyone wishing to object to the registration of these heraldic representations on the grounds that such registrations will encroach upon rights to which he or she is legally entitled should do so within one month of the date of publication of this notice upon a form obtainable from the State Herald, Private Bag X236, Pretoria, 0001.

1. APPLICANT: United School Sport Association of South Africa (USSASA): Learners with Special Education Needs (LSEN) (H4/3/1/4056)

ARMS: Sable, a guinea-fowl proper; in sinister chief a protea Or, seeded Argent.

2. APPLICANT: Rhodes University: Allan Webb Hall (H4/3/1/4059)

ARMS: Azure, two keys in saltire **Or**, between, in chief a mitre Argent, embellished Or, and Azure, and in base, an escallop also Argent.

3. APPLICANT: Rhodes University: Canterbury House (H4/3/1/4059)

ARMS: Or, a cross paty Azure, having conjoined to each arm a plate fimbriated Azure; on a chief escartelly dovetailed **also** Azure, **two** keys in saltire Or, surmounted by a mitre Argent, embellished Or.

4. APPLICANT: Rhodes University: Salisbury House (H4/3/1/4059)

ARMS: Or, a diadem consisting of five rays Azure, issuing from a circlet Argent, embellished Azure; on a chief escartelly dovetailed also Azure, **two** keys in saltire Or, surmounted by a mitre Argent, embellished Or.

5. **APPLICANT:** Rhodes University: Truro House (H4/3/1/4059)

ARMS: Or, a fleur-de-lis-Azure; on a chief escartelly dovetailed also Azure, two keys in saltire Or, surmounted by a mitre Argent, embellished Or.

6. **APPLICANT:** Rhodes University: Winchester House (H4/3/1/4059)

ARMS: Or, on a hurt a sun in splendour Or, charged with a rose per pale Argent and Gules; on a chief escartelly dovetailed Azure, two keys in saltire Or, surmounted by a mitre Argent, embellished Or.

7. APPLICANT: Greater Tzaneen Municipality (H4/3/2/725)

ARMS: Per fess embowed Vert, and Argent, in base two wavy bars Azure charged with an ethnically embellished **corn** stamping log and stamper proper; a chief firtree topped Or. The shield is ensigned of a fruit basket full of fruits, and flanked by a cycad proper.

MOTTO: FROM NATURE

8. APPLICANT: Nama Khoi Municipality (H4/3/2/751)

ARMS: Argent, in base issuant from the lower shield edge a quiver tree between dexter a bow and filled quiver proper, and sinister a faceted diamond Azure, in chief a Namaqualand Daisy proper. The shield is ensigned of a traditional indigenous Nama Khoi hut. Behind the shield two shepherds crooks in saltire proper.

MOTTO: ! Gai ûiba Sîsenba

9. **APPLICANT:** Modimolle Municipality (H4/3/2/764)

ARMS: Per fess Sable and Or, a barrulet Argent filleted Sable, charged with another Vert, between in chief dexter a ploughshare Argent and sinister a maize cob Argent, leaved Vert, and in base on a pile inverted couped Azure, **an** African Jacana Bird proper there below a barrulet wavy Argent, at fess point **an**

indigenous embellished clay pot proper, at nombril point a demi-sun Gules. The shield is ensigned of a traditional woman's head dress proper.

MOTTO: UNITY UNDERSTANDINGAND SUCCESS

10. APPLICANT: Mafube Municipality (H4/3/2/803)



ARMS: Per bend sinister Vert and Or, over the partition three wavy bendlets Argent alternated with as many Azure, between in chief dexter an ox head and neck reversed proper, and sinister a garb, charged with a maize cob Or, leafed Vert, and in base, issuant from the lower edge of the shield, a weeping willow tree proper. The shield is ensigned of a rustic mural crown **Brunâtre**, issuant therefrom a sun **Or**, rayed Gules. Flanked on both sides of the shield, an elephant tusk proper.
