

SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE**NOTICE IN TERMS OF THE PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY REGULATION ACT,
2001****(ACT No.56 OF 2001): EXEMPTION IN TERMS OF
SECTIONS 1(2) AND 20(5) OF THE ACT**

I, Charles Nqakula, Minister for **Safety and Security**, have, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 1(2) and 20(5) of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No. 56 of 2001) after consultation with the Council for the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority, exempted Elvey **Security Technologies (PTY) Limited**, from the obligation to register in terms of section 20(1)(a) of the Private Security Industry Regulations Act, 2001, on condition that "

- there is no change in the business activities of the company, as set out in its application for exemption, and
- the exemption will only be valid for a period of one year from the date hereof.
